Quattro Gatti will be served as the exclusive gin at cafés and restaurants inside Giardini della Biennale and Arsenale for the duration of Biennale Arte 2026, as well as official events during the pre-opening period. In celebration of this appointment, Quattro Gatti will be unveiling an exclusive Biennale Arte 2026 cocktail in the coming months.

Quattro Gatti Gin is an invitation to embrace the Italian way of life. Founded in Umbria, Quattro Gatti is a contemporary Italian gin shaped by place, craft, and a deep affinity for art and design. This reflects a natural alignment with Biennale Arte 2026, one of the world's most enduring cultural events and a global forum for artistic research, experimentation, and exchange. Created by the Mordant Family, Simon, Catriona, Angus, and Brielle, the brand was developed in line with their longstanding global contributions to arts and culture. Their commitment to supporting international creative communities, as demonstrated through their personal art collection and ongoing cultural patronage, is clearly evident in this groundbreaking partnership.

The Mordant family has shared a deep connection with Italy, and specifically La Biennale di Venezia, for over 20 years. Simon Mordant served as the Commissioner for the Australia Pavilion at Biennale Arte 2013 and 2015, and is currently the Global Ambassador and advocate for Australia's participation at Biennale Arte 2026. In 2015, the Mordant family initiated and led the rebuilding of the Australian Pavilion, making it the first 21st century building in Venice. Simon Mordant also holds the title Knight of the Order of the Star of Italy for his contributions to the arts and business, is a supporter of the Venetian Heritage Foundation, was appointed the Inaugural International Ambassador for Gallerie dell'Accademia in Venice, and co-funds the Venice FutureS initiative.

"What began as a quiet family retreat and cultural admiration has now evolved into a source of creative inspiration, shaped by Italy's landscape, traditions, and community," said Simon Mordant, Founder of Quattro Gatti Gin. "Quattro Gatti is our way of bottling the spirit of this special place. To be named Official Gin of Biennale Arte 2026 is an honor that is aligned with who we are, why we make this gin, and our special connection to both Venice and Umbria."
