Full price € 30

Reduced price € 20 over 65, Venice residents (a valid ID is required at the entrance)

Students and/or Under 26 € 16 (a valid ID or student card is required at the entrance)

MULTIPLE-ACCESS TICKETS*

3-Day ticket € 40 (valid for 3 consecutive days, closing days are excluded from the day count)

Weekly ticket € 50 (valid for 7 consecutive days, closing days are excluded from the day count)

Biennale Sessions ticket € 20 (for affiliated universities, reservation required, min. 50 participants)

SPECIAL PRICES

Visitors with a certified disability may purchase one-access tickets at € 20 reduced price.

These tickets may be purchased at the Ticket Office/Infopoint (Viale Trento at Giardini / Riva di Ca' di Dio at Arsenale) by producing the necessary documents. Persons accompanying disabled visitors (if it is certified in the documents produced) may request a complimentary ticket at the Ticket Office/Infopoint.

Special prices also for **FAI, ACI, COOP, CRAL DOGANE, OCRAD, TCI** card holders:

€ 26 concession one-access ticket; the card must be presented at the Ticket Office/Infopoint at the time of purchase.

FREE ADMISSION

Children up to 6 years old (included); adults accompanying disabled visitors holding a disability ID (if it is certified in the documents produced); nursery schools, elementary schools and junior high schools participating in Biennale Educational activities.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR VISITORS

In the event of inappropriate behaviour towards artworks or people, the security personnel the right to ask the visitors involved to qualify and to have them removed from the Exhibition. In case of persistence of behaviour incompatible with security, the Biennale Management reserves the right to take appropriate initiatives and measures, including the suspension of access to the Exhibition.

Groups with a guide should limit the number of participants to 25. In case of overcrowding or other particular circumstances, as deemed by the Management, large groups will be asked to be divided into smaller groups during their visit.

SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE EXHIBITION VENUES

Courtesy transport service with electric cars for visitors with reduced mobility. Subject to availability: walkers, wheelchairs (upon request to the personnel).

For families: restroom with changing table, strollers (upon request to the personnel).

Large bags, suitcases and luggage not allowed. There is a free cloakroom for small items. It is not possible to store luggage and suitcases.

Restaurants: both venues host a restaurant and other refreshment stands (as shown in maps). Menus available for people with celiac disease, vegetarians and vegans.

Only small- to medium-sized animals on a leash are permitted, and exclusively within the green area of the Giardini venue.

In agreement with BAUADVISOR, a paid Dog Sitter and Dog Walker service is available and must be booked at least 24 hours in advance at the following link: <https://www.bauadvisor.it/>. The service provided by BAUADVISOR allows pet dog owners who intend to visit the Exhibition to entrust their dog to the BAUADVISOR operators at the entrance of the Exhibition venues, on the date and at the established time until the end of the visit, when it will be returned to the owner.
